
Many New SOLOS Members We are thrilled to report the current SOLOS membership at 1,415. That is 1,415 adult residents of Rancho Murieta who care about our reservoir lakes and pristine open spaces, and who will get involved and resist future development that negatively impacts our community services and resources.

Approved New Development On-going
The new development that is currently on going at the Retreats (North) and Riverview (South), and other approved parcels adjacent to Stonehouse Park (Residence East & West) and by the CSD, 39 acres, will add approximately 648 residences. Lots of obstacles with the later two developments.

New Proposed Development (not yet approved) Rancho North Properties has an application at the Sac County Planning Dept. for 697 additional homes divided in 8 Villages, most around our lakes and open spaces.


New Major Problem......We don't have enough water to support the new proposed development. CSD has paid approximately \$400K to an engineering firm to complete a new Integrated Water Master Plan that is nearly complete. At first glimpse of this very involved study, it appears fairly clear that our reservoirs, where our water is stored before going through the water treatment plant, are not large enough to store the water we will need for 697 more homes.

And, options to enhance our storage capacity such as deepening the reservoirs, putting in a well or two, or using Lake Clementia are either cost prohibitive or not legal options. Relying on a conservation level of 30% or more might supply more water but is that really fair to ask current residents to use 30% less water so that new residences can be built? Will the new residences have to conserve 30% as well? Lots of questions about this issue. See CSD Mtgs. info below.
